9. Description of the grave:

The victims, apart from no. 7, were buried in a common grave.

10. Was there an official exhumation? Were the corpses buried officially, and if so, where?

The corpses were officially exhumed on 12 June 1945 and buried in the section of honor of a cemetery in the following graves: 1) 98, 2) 93, 3) 95, 4) 99, 5) 98, 6) 100, 7) 94.

11. Are there any grounds for exhumation in the future?

On 6 October 1945, the contents of the above questionnaire were officially certified by Ludwika Bazylewska, acting on the authorization of the president of the city of Kielce, with the Municipal Court in Kielce.
