2 June 1943 in Kakonin, Bieliny commune

4. **Is it known what the victims were accused of, whether the execution was carried out in retaliation, etc.?**
They were political suspects.
5. **Who carried out the execution?**
The execution was carried out by the Gendarmerie from the station in Bieliny.
6. **Are the surnames of the perpetrators known?**
Gendarmerie Lieutenant Wagner
7. **Were the corpses burnt or destroyed in any other way?**
The corpses were buried in Kakonin, Bieliny commune.
8. **Where were the corpses buried?**
In Kakonin, Bieliny commune.
9. **Description of the grave:**
2 meters long, 2 meters wide. 9 people are buried in it.
10. **Was there an official exhumation? Were the corpses buried officially, and if so, where?**

11. **Are there any grounds for exhumation in the future?**

On 16 October 1945, the contents of the above questionnaire were officially certified by Adam Skrzyniarz, the head of Bieliny commune, with the Municipal Court in Daleszyce.
